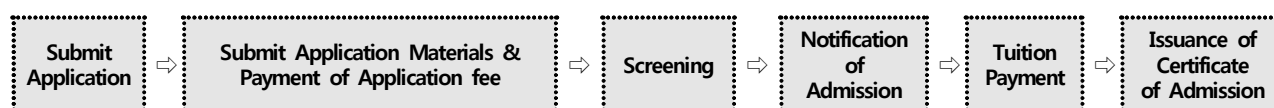

3 Eligibility

□ Qualification (Admission conditions 1~3 should be surely satisfied)

- The applicant and both of his/her parents should be non-Korean or the applicant should have completed his/her whole education period (from elementary school to high school) abroad regardless of parents' nationalities.
※ Korean national (Including the applicant with dual nationalities or whose parents hold dual nationalities) or applicant who gained non-korean nationality less than two years ago is not eligible for the admission.
- Applicant should have **level 3 or higher in Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK)**. **But the applicants whose major is Science and Engineering, Art, Music and Physical Education are allowed to be admitted with level 2 in TOPIK only if it is approved by the department.** (Note: Some department may demand higher TOPIK score than required by IALE. **In that case, department's decision has priority.**)
- If the applicant entered the university with TOPIK Level 2, they must complete at least 400 hours' Korean language course at IALE within 1 year after the admission. (If not, scholarship cannot be given.)**
- For foreigner of Korean ancestry living in China, Russia, Central Asia or America, the training hours of Korean language course at NIIED in Korea can be recognized as the required Korean language training hours.

□ Admission Types

- Freshman : Freshman admission (Study years are 8 semesters or longer for BA degree)
- Transfer : Junior (third year) admission (Study years are 4 semesters or longer for BA degree)

□ Graduation Requirement

Most of departments have set TOPIK level 4 as the graduation requirement and the following departments has set TOPIK level 3. [*Fine Arts, Design, Music, Sports Science, Information & Telecommunication Eng., Civil Eng., Environmental Eng., Shipbuilding & Marine Eng., Mechanical Convergence System Eng., Marine Biotechnology*]

- Documents submitted by the graduates from the institutions in China must be accompanied by verification issued at the websites: <http://www.cdgdcd.edu.cn>, <http://www.chsi.com.cn>
- **No.5~No.7 documents should be in Korean or English. (If not, submit the translation.)**
- KNU may request additional documents for admission screening.

(1) Levels, Grades and Completion

- Levels: Basic (1, 2), Intermediate (1, 2), Advanced (1, 2)
- Grade Evaluation: Mid-term exam (40%), final exam (40%), attendance (10%), homework (10%)
- Mock-TOPIK at the end of every session
- Certificate of completion is issued only in case of 80% or higher attendance rate
