thirty

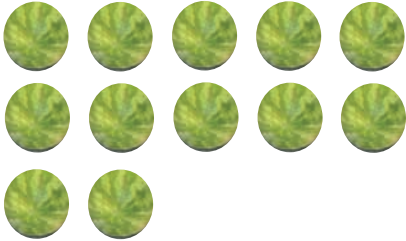
I count 30 cherries in the bowl.
